As Jesus ascended into heaven He empowered His apostles and disciples to, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all I have commanded you. And behold I am with you always until the end of the age." [Matthew 28:19-20]

The Solemnities of Ascension and Pentecost are celebrated just a week apart and close the Easter Season. Today's solemnity is rooted in the mission of Jesus Christ. Those left behind, following Jesus' glorious Ascension into heaven, must carry on the mission. Jesus will guide His disciples through the Holy Spirit until Christ returns in glory at the end of time.

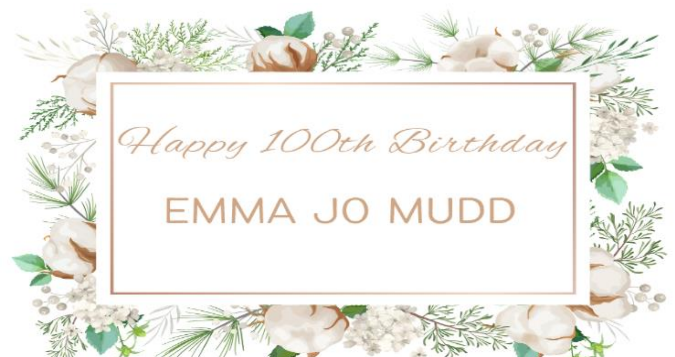

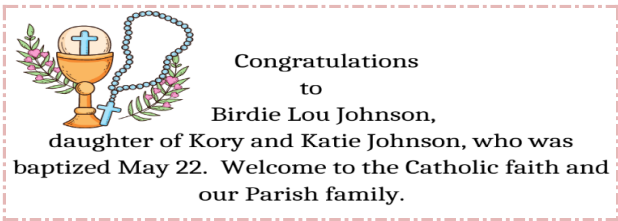
