June 12, 2022 The Most Holy Trinity

Dear Parishioners,

Today is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. The Church calls us to recognize that God is Lord of Heaven and Earth and to bow our heads to the will of God and show reverence for God’s presence in all things. The Grace of our Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you. The Trinity is certainly a Mystery of Faith and yet as we attempt to solve the mystery we are continually in wonder and awe at the awesomeness of our God.



When we sin, God does not disappear until we summon Him for forgiveness and absolution, God the Spirit stands by us when we choose to sin, as our Advocate and guide, hoping that we will soon choose what is right. Our Triune God then shows us the way out of sin and the way back to God’s mercy and Grace.

Corpus Christi Procession: The Solemnity of the Body & Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) is celebrated next weekend. After the 9:30 Mass at Holy Rosary Church **next Sunday**, all parishioners from both parishes are invited to take part in the **Corpus Christi Procession** with the Holy Eucharist through one block of Monroe City. The procession will begin after the Prayer after Communion. The servers, carrying the cross, candles and incense, will lead the procession followed by children scattering flower petals and the Knights of Columbus carrying the canopy over the priest who holds the Monstrance. All the faithful will follow behind. The procession will travel one easy block through the streets of Monroe City. [Lawn Street and cut over to Cleveland Street] If you have difficulty walking the whole procession, feel free to walk with us to the first altar at the convent and then return to church and pray for the rest of us until we return to Church for Benediction. You are also welcome to remain in church for the whole procession. Please bring any flower petals that you may have from your blooming flowers. We will collect them before each of the morning Masses.

Since 1246 A.D., this procession with the Blessed Sacrament is a wonderful tradition of literally “bringing Christ to the world” in which we live. Please read the attached insert for more information about this Catholic rite and custom.

Piety (or Reverence) and Fear of the Lord are Gifts of the Holy Spirit. Holy Trinity Sunday and the Solemnity of Corpus Christi remind us to bow in reverence to the awesome power and gracious love of God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
