Dear Parishioners,

Happy Birthday! This weekend is the Solemnity of Pentecost and it is a celebration of the Birthday of the Church.

The apostles went out to all people and all nations to preach the Truth. They were given a message by Jesus Christ to tell all the nations of the love and saving power of God. We have been given a similar Mission by our Baptism and Confirmation. These sacraments give us the grace to witness the faith to our families, friends, strangers, and foes. We witness the love and mercy of God through our words, and especially our actions, as disciples of Jesus. Do people know we are Christian before we tell them?



Let your prayer this week reflect on the gifts of the Holy Spirit and how God is calling you to use these gifts you have been given. The Gifts of the Holy Spirit are: **WISDOM, KNOWLEDGE, UNDERSTANDING, FORTITUDE** (or Courage), **RIGHT JUDGEMENT, PIETY** (or Reverence), and **FEAR OF THE LORD** (or Wonder and Awe).

The Fruits of the Holy Spirit: **Charity, Joy, Peace, Patience, Kindness, Goodness, Generosity, Gentleness, Faithfulness, Modesty, Self-Control, and Chastity** are desperately needed in our society. Remember Jesus' metaphor 'I am the vine and you are the branches...remain in me', when we are attached to the vine we continue to 'bear fruit'. How can we bear the fruits of the Holy Spirit this week? Look at that listing of the Fruits of the Holy Spirit once again and commit to promoting at least three of those virtues this summer. Trust in the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. They will help us bear fruit sixty, eighty and one hundred-fold.

On this Pentecost Sunday, **I give every parishioner a challenge to invite two families and/or individuals to come back to Church before the year is out.** Invite them to come to Mass with you and invite them to parish events. As you meet people in times of need, when you are living out those Fruits of the Holy Spirit, serve them well and remind them that you find your strength and hope in your Catholic Faith that is sustained by the Mass and the sacraments. **Trust in the Gifts of the Holy Spirit and know that Christ is counting on you.**

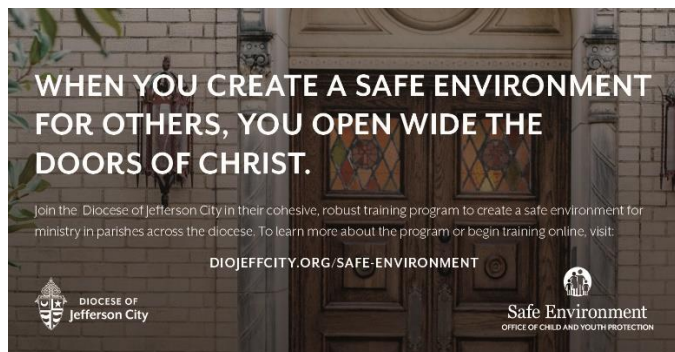
