- Painting has been completed.
- Anchors were put in convent wall by Foundation Recovery Systems.

- Church renovation report: Committee has been meeting. Approximately 9-10 people on the committee and meetings have gone very well. Another meeting Tuesday night. Father signed a contract with an architect at Michael Purol's firm. He is putting together a rendering. Going to be doing tack point and scaling on all three buildings. Dennis Long is heading the construction part. We have reached out to 4 general contractors. 1 contractor has done a walk through. A second contractor is coming tomorrow to do a walk through. Associate Craft came to look at the stain glass windows and take measurements to prepare their bid. The windows in the balcony probably will not have a design but be colored panels. Also, stain glass in the Sacristy and bathroom. Those windows may just be colored panes. Families will have the opportunity to buy sections.
- Father has his third meeting with the Steier Group tomorrow. The Steier Group is getting ready to interview parishioners. Anticipate these interviews will begin late February.
- Received \$50,000 from a pledge being filled. The loan is now less than \$150,000. Therefore, it will be rolled into the new loan so there is just one loan.
- There is an established renovation account. It contains greater than \$15,000.
- Father Greg countered the proposed offer for the old school property with the amount of \$55,000. He has not heard back from them. He will see them tomorrow at the Ministerial Alliance meeting and will follow up.
- The Quarterly Central Deanery Meeting is February 22, 2022.
