## DECREE

### *Declaration of Boundaries for a Parish*

I, the undersigned Bishop of Jefferson City, hereby state the following in regard to the parish of

Holy Rosary, Monroe City:

*Whereas*, the formal decree establishing the parochial territory of this parish no longer exists, and there is a need to provide for an orderly record of the boundaries of this parish; and

*Whereas*, having received the proposal of the former Hannibal Deanery on the boundaries of this parish, and after consultation with the Presbyteral Council on 13 October 2020 in accordance with canon 515 §2;

*Therefore*, by this DECREE, I hereby declare that the territory of this parish shall be bounded by the following:

North – The intersecting point at Hwy W and County Rd. 248 following east on Co.Rd. 248 and continuing along an imaginary line due east to intersect with Hwy 168 then following south to Co.Rd. 199 then east on Co.Rd. 268 and continuing along an imaginary line due east to intersect with Hwy Z; following Hwy Z south to Co.Rd. 240 then east and continuing along an imaginary line due east to intersect with Hwy E.

South – The Salt River and the eastern portion of the Clarence Cannon Reservoir/Mark Twain Lake to Co.Rd 595 following north onto Hwy N, continuing north onto Hwy 24 and following an imaginary line north to the intersection of Co.Rd. 370; following Co.Rd. 370 west onto Co.Rd. 377 and south onto Co.Rd. 360 then west onto Co.Rd. 360 and onto Hwy F continuing onto Hwy FF to the intersecting point of Black Creek.

East – From a point on Hwy E due west from Co.Rd. 240 and following Hwy E south and continuing Hwy DD to the Salt River.

West – From the intersecting point of Hwy FF and Black Creek following an imaginary line due north to the intersection of Hwy T and continuing north onto Hwy W to the intersection of Co.Rd. 248.

All things to the contrary notwithstanding.
