Religious Education Report from Donna Long and Courtney Benson (proclaim the word of the Gospel through education; PSR, RCIA, Youth Groups, and Bible Studies) Leanna Moss, Marie Little, Toni Hunter

- Youth led Mass at Holy Rosary planned for 1/28/23 at 5:30 with PSR Family dinner for K-12 PSR students.
- RCIA Rite of Welcoming/Acceptance was 12/4/22. Rite of Welcoming is for those seeking full communion in the Church (those already validly baptized). Rite of Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens is for those who are not baptized. Eleven people are in the RCIA program.
- Confirmation Retreat at HRS on 2/18/23 from 9:30-3. Retreat is Diocesan requirement for Confirmation. Retreats are organized at the Diocesan level. Four retreat options include 1/28/23 in Jeff City led by NET Ministries, 2/18/23 at HRS led by Benedictine College Set Free Retreat Team, and Quest Retreats on 12/9/22 & 2/3/23 in Quincy at Franciscan Retreat Center
- Need small group facilitators from both HR & SS for Grateful Living the Joy of Stewardship groups. This is Lenten parish study. Order books soon.
- Flocknote launched on the weekend of 1/31/22 and 1/1/23. Currently we have 201 members in the account (136 for HR and 59 for SS). A large portion of people have not signed up and some began the process but never finished it (only listed phone numbers with no names). Melody, Sally and Donna have begun having a "Flocknote Footnotes" section in the bulletin. Flocknote will not work as we hope unless we encourage people to sign up.
- SEC has met 4 times this semester & 2 times for tailgating with good attendance; about 35 7th & 8th graders. Plan to meet 1x in Jan and 2x in Feb.
- Chosen Youth group met about 8 times this semester with attendance varying from 10-30 depending on other events. Plan to meet 1/25/23, 2/1/23 & 2/8/23.
- Twenty-two 7-12th graders attended Vivo Cristo Rey in Columbia
- Courtney getting dates for summer camps/events. Steubenville sign up is in Feb.
- Youth groups need food sign ups for both groups.
